



BYOD Policy for Students

1. Students may bring personal Digital Technology devices such as laptop computers, tablets and portable data storage devices to school for educational purposes.
 - The use of these devices in a classroom must not in any way disrupt the learning environment.
 - Students are not allowed to use their devices for entertainment or gaming purposes at school.
 - Equipment storing any images, files, programs, applications or data not appropriate in an educational setting is not allowed on school premises or school activities.
2. Items are brought to the school at the risk of the owner. The school assumes no financial liability for this equipment. Insurance is the owner's responsibility.
 - Students are responsible for securing their own equipment and ensuring that it is not damaged. Should an item be stolen it will be reported to the Principal, or Principal's delegate, who will determine the appropriate extent to which an investigation will occur.
3. Glossop High School is not responsible for the maintenance of personally owned equipment.
4. Teachers will allow students to use private laptop computers in their class for activities where it is appropriate. Each teacher will outline specific guidelines for their classroom.
5. Devices must only be operated on the device's battery. Students are not to plug in their devices for charging into school power points. It is recommended that students have a backup battery if their device cannot remain charged for the day. This is a workplace safety issue.
6. Student devices cannot be attached to the school domain network, i.e. stand-alone only.
7. Students may have their laptops set up to access the Internet via the wireless network if:
 - They have at least one fully updated version of *Spybot*, *AVG Free*(Win 7 or 8/8.1) Windows defender(Win 10 only) or McAfee
 - These are available in: (P)Public\AVG Free\
 - They allow the ICT Technician to install a monitoring/connection program on them.
 - They allow their laptop to be checked at random intervals.
8. Any violation of this policy may result in the revocation of the right to use a private digital technology device at Glossop High School in addition to behaviour related consequences.
